RE: Financial Aid Database (FAD) Report Portal Open - FY 2018 (2017-18)

Over the past year, Coordinating Board staff has worked extensively with a subcommittee of the Financial Aid Advisory Committee to develop a plan for streamlining and improving reporting of financial aid data. As a result, a new FAD Report and validation/certification web portal were designed to consolidate reporting and allow institutions the ability to electronically sign completed reports online.

Beginning FY 2018, institutions are required to follow a new FAD reporting schedule consisting of three separate reports. The first two reports are intended to validate the reported data and the final report is to certify the data. The additional reporting cycles will incorporate relevant data that was previously submitted on other reports. (e.g. TEG Need Survey and End-of-Year reports).

The first reporting cycle for the FY 2018 FAD Report begins December 1, 2017. Attached is a link to the revised FAD manual for FY 2018. Several webinars will be posted to the Student Financial Aid Programs (SFAP) Information website under the training section in the coming weeks to assist institutions with the transition to the new reporting cycles and process.

Institutions will submit files for processing using the secure data exchange process, <u>MOVEit DMZ</u>. More information on MOVEit DMZ can be found in the <u>User Guide</u> located on the Student Financial Aid Information website. The deadline dates for each submission are listed below:

Institutions are required to submit a separate FAD report for each reporting cycle and should allow sufficient time to resolve errors and reconcile data by the specified deadlines. The FAD report must reconcile with the information reported for state financial aid programs and the CBM001 enrollment report. The FAD Report for the first reporting cycle must be validated online through CBPass. Current users will need log in to CBPass and click My Access to request the new "Financial Aid Data Certification" application. First-time users will be required to create a profile for CBPass and then request access to the online validation/certification application.
