### Frequently Asked Questions

#### **1. What are the grant periods for Competitions 1 and 2?**

Projects proposed for Competitions 1 and 2 may have a grant period of up to 24 months. The total award for that grant period is up to \$200,000 for Competition 1 and up to \$175,000 for Competition 2.

#### **2. What does “renewable” mean?**

Successful projects for Competitions 1 and 2 may be renewed following their first grant period. In other words, institutions may re-apply for additional funding during the annual Perkins State Leadership Grant offering for their existing projects once the initial grant period is completed. Requests for renewal will be made under Competition 3, Continuation. Continuation grants have a 12-month timeline with the possibility for renewal for another 12 months.

#### **3. Can we apply for multiple Perkins State Leadership Grant Competitions in a given year?**

Yes.

#### **4. Can we apply again next year if we apply this year? Can we apply again next year if we get a grant this year?**

Institutions can apply again for a grant in 2020-21 if they apply in 2019-20, whether or not a project is funded for 2019-20. Institutions that get projects funded this year should only apply next year for new projects, or for renewal of twelve-month projects that end by the close of 2019-20. Projects funded for a greater than 12-month period in 2019-20 should not apply for renewal in 2020-21 .

#### **5. We are existing grantees and want to apply for another round of funding through Competition 3. Do we need to submit a Pre-Proposal?**

No. Pre-Proposals are not required for Competition 3 applicants. Institutions must, however, provide notice of intent to apply by email to Perkins Contact Mindy Nobles on or before April 22, 2019.

#### **6. Are matching funds for the proposed project required?**

No. However, if invited to provide a full proposal, institutions may be making the case that the project is aligned with, enhancing or supplementing existing projects. If so, please describe existing funding and sources of that funding.
