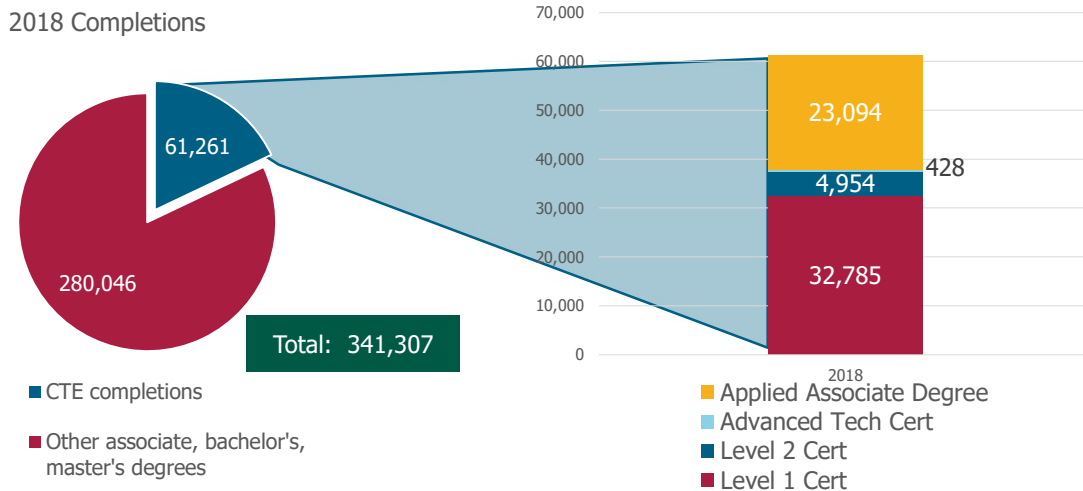

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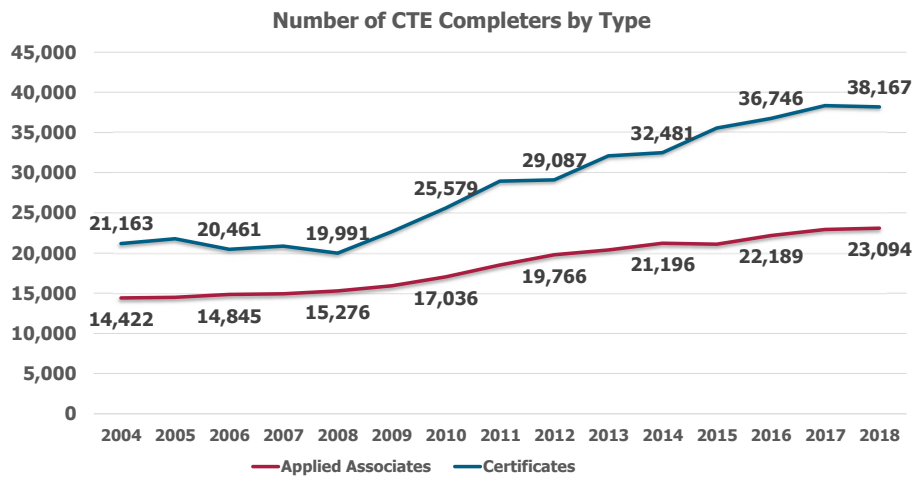
About 18% of completions counted toward the Completion Goal are in CTE



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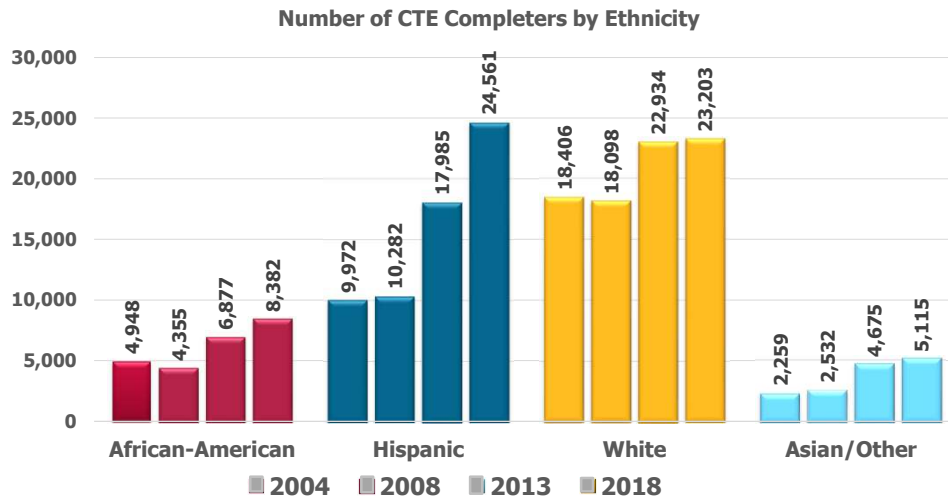
The number of CTE completions have increased since 2004. Certificate completions have increased more than 90% since the 2008 recession



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The number of CTE completions by Hispanic students grew almost 150% from 2004 to 2018; CTE completions were up for all other major groups, as well

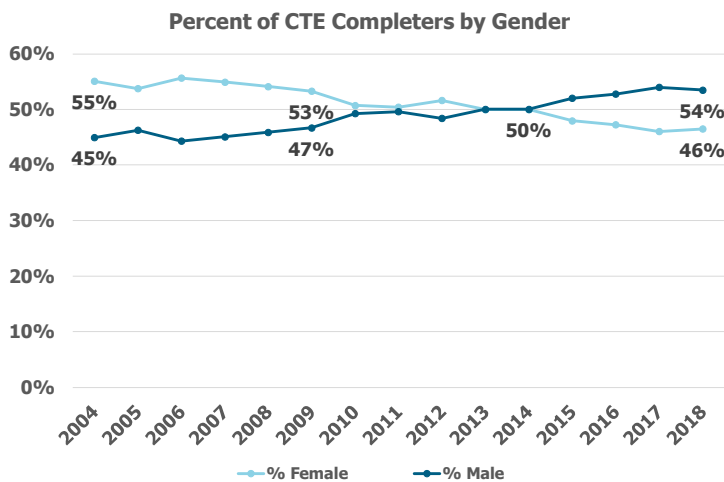


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The percent of CTE completers by gender has gradually reversed from 55% female completers in 2004 to 54% male completers in 2018

 - Business Admin/Management & Operations

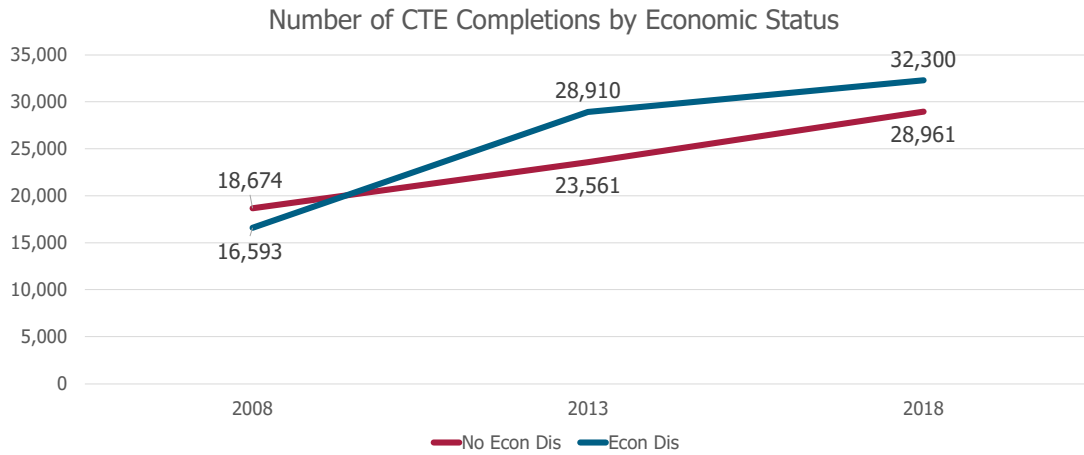


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Since 2008, the number of CTE completions by economically disadvantaged students has exceeded the number for non-economically disadvantaged students



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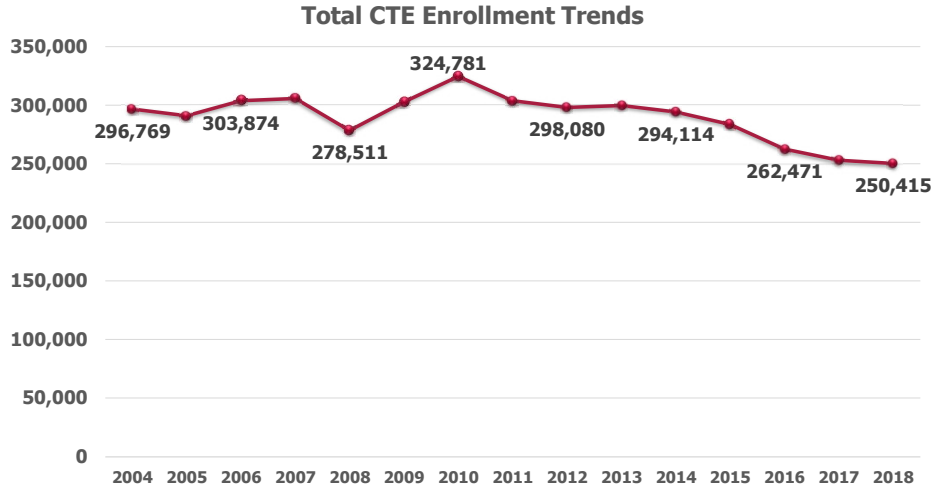
Two health-related programs were among the top 5 producing programs

Business Administration, Management and Operations	4,668
Precision Metal Working	4,271
Vehicle Maintenance and Repair Technologies	3,877
Allied Health Diagnostic, Intervention, and Treatment Professions	3,829



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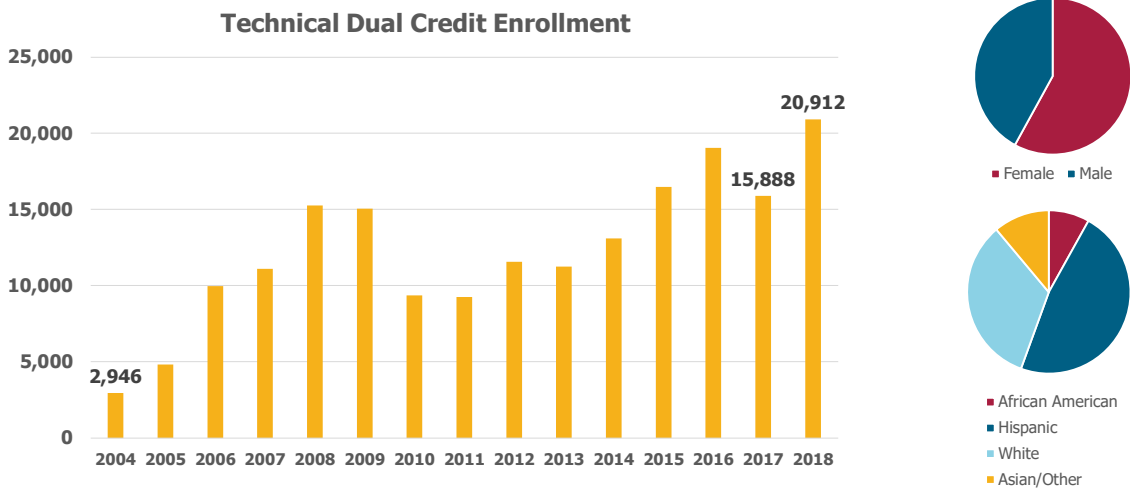
Unlike CTE completions, CTE enrollments have been steadily declining since 2010, decreasing to their lowest in 2018



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Fewer than 3,000 students enrolled in CTE dual credit in 2004. By 2018, about 21,000 students did so



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Summary.....

- CTE programs prepare students with the technical skills needed in the workforce
- CTE completions make up almost 20% of the Completion Goal
- CTE completions are on the rise, particularly certificates
- Dual credit enrollment in CTE is also on the rise, though still relatively small in scale
- CTE enrollments overall have declined, which may suggest graduation rates for these credentials are increasing
