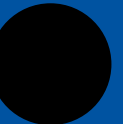

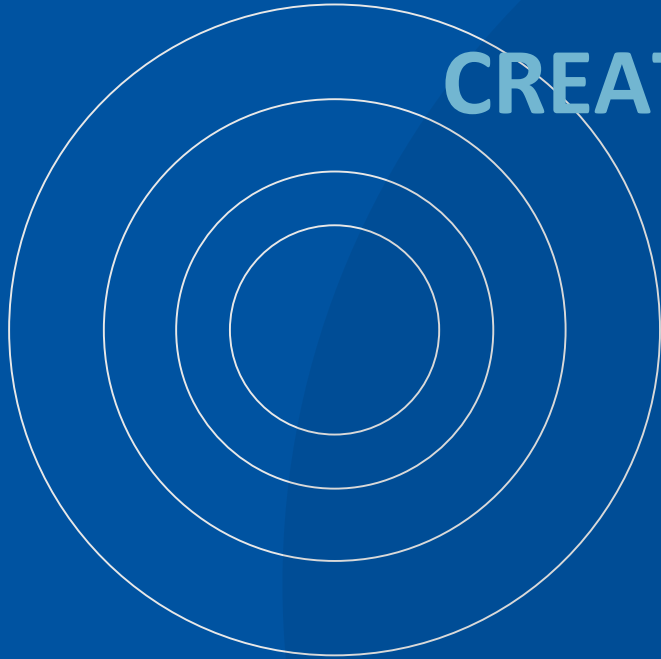

 - ALLOWS FOR COMPARISON ACROSS PROGRAMS
 - COMMON TEMPLATE IMPROVES NAVIGATION AND FACILITATES TRAINING
- GUIDED PATHWAYS
 - FULL-TIME 8-SEMESTER FORMAT
 - DEFAULT COURSES SELECTED BY INSTITUTIONS
 - STACKABILITY ALLOWS FOR WORKFORCE ENTRY

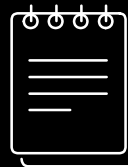

Pursuant to TEC §28.014, these courses must be designed for students at the 12th grade level whose performance on an EOC assessment instrument does not meet college readiness standards or whose performance on coursework, a college entrance examination, or an assessment instrument designated under Section 51.3062(c) indicates that the student is not ready to perform entry-level college coursework. These college preparatory courses are eligible for state credit on the Foundation High School Program only.
