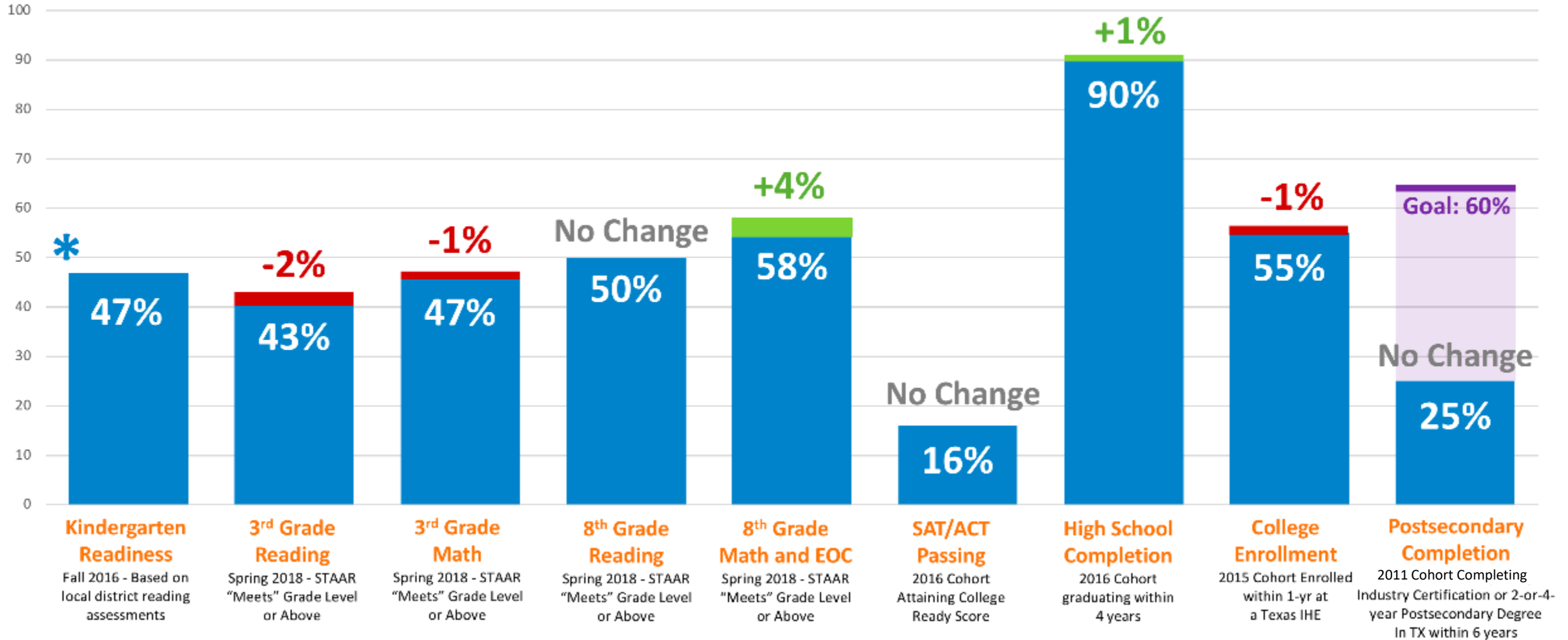


Texas Education Performance Indicators



HB3 – School Finance Overhaul - Highlights



Improved Equity and Access

- Pays for **one** college prep exams: TSIA, ACT, or SAT for every student in their junior/senior year
- Requires FAFSA completion for high school graduation (**allows for a parent opt-out**)

- Extended Elementary School Year
- PK-3 Reading Support + Dyslexia
- **CCM-Readiness Outcomes Bonus**
- Dual Language
- Blended Learning

- ✓ Teacher Incentive Funding

Improved Equity

- ✓ Comp Ed increased to 0.225 - 0.275 based on density of poverty
- ✓ Current Year values equalizing Tier 1
- ✓ Equal treatment of ASF funding



Reduce Property Tax Growth and Reduce Recapture

- ✓ Tier 1 Tax Rates drop 7% immediately
- ✓ Copper pennies compressed by half (capacity remains)
- ✓ Additional two golden pennies (from 6 to 8)
- ✓ Tier 1 Tax Rates decline as property values grow more than 2.5%, stabilizing state share percentage
- ✓ School Board discretion for up to 5 (from 4) golden pennies without a TRE
