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## Bridging Disciplines Programs

- 16 interdisciplinary certificates
- Complement a range of majors
- Develop a secondary specialization while satisfying degree requirements – does not extend time to degree
- May satisfy core, elective, and some major requirements



## Bridging Disciplines Programs

- 19 credit hours:
  - BDP 101 forum seminar
  - Interdisciplinary coursework, drawn from existing course offerings across campus
  - Connecting Experiences: research, internships, and creative projects
  - Integration essay

- Prepare students for a professional world that values innovation, flexibility, and collaboration
- Overseen by cross-college faculty committees
- About 700 active students

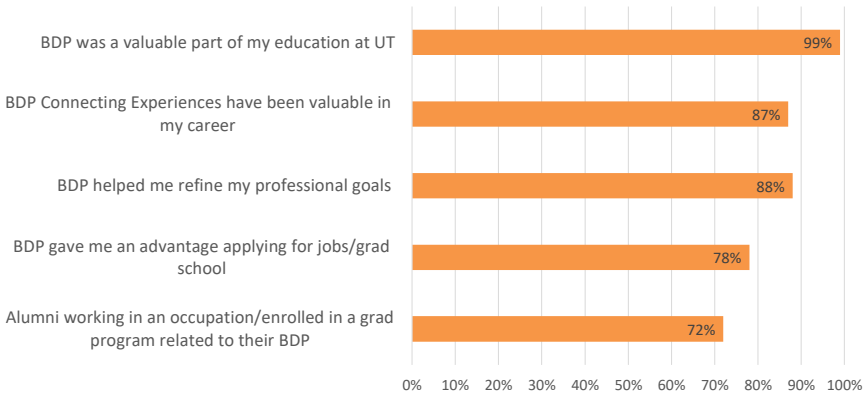
