

Reconciling State Aid Programs

THECB program totals are derived from:

Validated total from Cycle Two (includes any funds requested, transferred or returned after validation)

- Tuition Equalization Grant (TEG)
- Texas Educational Opportunity Grant (TEOG)
- Toward EXcellence, Access, and Success (TEXAS) Grant

- Educational Aide Exemption (EAE)
- Bilingual Education Scholarship
- Texas College Work-Study (TCWS)

Funds disbursed as of Sept. 24, 2019

- B-On-Time (BOT)
- College Access Loan (CAL)
- Texas Armed Services Scholarship (TASSP)




Reconciliation Form

Submit a **FAD Reconciliation Form** for each program flagged ***Reconcile** on the Reconciliation Report.

- Enter the correct student count and/or disbursed amount.
- Provide an explanation for the reason(s) data is being changed.
- If a refund is required, submit a Return of Funds Form, then proceed to step 4.

FAD Reconciliation Updates will be processed after funds are received.

What is Cyber Security?

User Access Portal Review

To comply with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's (THECB) privacy and security policy, the Director of Financial Aid must verify the THECB's list of designated portal users. The primary financial aid portals include:

- HelmNet
- CBPass
- MOVEit DMZ





Follow 3 easy steps to complete the user access portal review.

Step 1. Review your institution's user accounts listed on the **User Access spreadsheet** for the three web portals. Determine whether updates are needed.

Step 2. Complete and submit the required **User Access Verification Survey** to confirm that all users were reviewed.

Step 3. Submit a **System Authorization Form** for any updates to your institution's user accounts.
