Example of data from FAD...

Although more than \$12 billion in student financial aid was awarded from federal, institutional, private, and state funding sources in FY 2018, there was a significant amount of unmet financial need among students attending Texas institutions of higher education. The average annual amount needed per student to cover the gap between undergraduate education costs and student resources (Expected Family Contribution [EFC] and financial aid) was:

- \$7,579 for students attending public two-year institutions,
- \$6,258 for students attending public universities and health-related institutions (HRIs), and
- > \$8,616 for students attending private or independent institutions.

FY 2019 FAD review revealed:

- Inflated COA
- Enrollment hours
- Ministry-related degree
- Hardship/Justification

Reminders and Updates:

- Reminder: Reporting cycle one deadline is April 17, 2020.
- Clarification: Reporting cycle one requires all students to be reported under option "3 Reporting Cycle 1" and not option "0 Not a recipient" for Data Elements #110 #112
- **Update:** Changes to the 2019-20 manual for reporting cycle two will include additional notes and alert boxes for clarification.
- **Update:** For 2019-20, reporting cycle two will require only a "Warning" for reconciliation.
