¹ A child support obligor who is more than thirty (30) days delinquent in paying child support, and a business entity in which the obligor is a sole proprietor, partner, shareholder, or owner with an owner interest of at least 25% is not eligible to receive state payments from state funds under a contract to provide property, materials or service; or receive a state-funded grant or loan until: 1) All arrears have been paid; 2) The obligor is in compliance with a written repayment agreement or court order as to any existing delinquency; or 3) a court-ordered exemption has been granted.
