Application Process Requirements for TXWORKS Internships

> To apply for TXWORKS internships, you must provide proof of program participation eligibility to TXWORKS employers by submitting these three required items:

Step 1: Review Items Required to Apply for TXWORKS Internships

Required Item	Description of Required Item		
Required Item I	Official Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) Student Eligibility Letter stating your eligibility for the Internship Period applying for.		
	Copy of your transcript (unofficial copy is acceptable) from ALL eligible colleges or universities in Texas that demonstrates the following for the semester prior to the internship period applying for:		
Required Item II	 Enrollment for at least the number of hours required of a half-time student (6 hours or more) as an undergraduate student enrolled in a degree or certificate program (Certificate, Associate, or Bachelor degree) at an eligible Texas college or university. 		
	NOTE: The prior semester to an internship period is defined as follows:		
	The prior semester to the Summer internship period will be the spring semester. The prior semester to the Fall internship period will be the summer or spring semester. The prior semester to the Spring internship period will be the fall semester.		
Required Item III	TX Internship Application completed and submitted through <u>www.TxInternshipChallenge.com</u> site.		

To begin to submit the above required items, follow Step 2 on page 3 to complete the TXWORKS Student Eligibility Form.

Notification of Eligibility to Apply	After you submit this form, you will receive an email notifying you of your eligibility status related to applying for TXWORKS internships with TXWORKS employers posted on the www.TxInternshipChallenge.com site. The email notification will include an official Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) TXWORKS Student Eligibility Letter if you are eligible. This letter must be provided to the TXWORKS employer when applying for a TXWORKS internship.

If you received a THECB TXWORKS Student Eligibility Letter stating that you are eligible to apply for an upcoming TXWORKS internship period, proceed to Step 3.

Step 3: Obtain a Copy of Your College or University Transcript

	Obtain and download a digital or hard copy of your college or university transcript (unofficial is acceptable) from ALL eligible colleges or universities in Texas that demonstrates the following for the prior semester to the internship period applying for:

HELPFUL TIP: Consult with your campus registrar's office or an academic advisor on how to access your transcript if you do not already know how to do so.

After you have received an official THECB Student Eligibility Letter and obtained a copy of your transcript that demonstrates the requirements outlined above in Step 3, proceed to Step 4.

HELPFUL TIP: Sign-Up to Receive Updates When New TXWORKS Employers and TXWORKS Internship Opportunities are Added!

Each semester, more employers will be added to the TXWORKS Internship Program and therefore, more internship opportunities are expected to be available. Provide your email address through the <u>TXWORKS Internship Program Questions and Contacts Form</u> to:

- Submit questions about the program.
- Receive updates about the TXWORKS Internship Program, which will include when TXWORKS internship positions are posted and the TXWORKS Student Eligibility Form is available to submit each semester.
- If you find an internship that is of interest to you and you meet the qualifications, proceed to Step 6.
