Qualifying Event for degree students tuition recovery

Quest College was required to maintain a surety instrument sufficient to allow fulfillment of its educational obligations of the <u>current term</u> to its enrolled students if the institution violated any minimum standard which resulted in loss of prepaid tuition or fees or was unable to continue to provide instruction to its enrolled students. THECB has determined that the December 6, 2022 closure was a Qualifying Event in which a student or enrollee of the school or his/her parent or guardian may be determined to have suffered loss of tuition or fees.

The AAS Medical Assisting/Allied Health program was offered under a Certificate of Authorization issued by THECB. Degree students may qualify for tuition and fee reimbursement. An application claim form and additional information is available <u>Student Recovery Application</u>. Claims must be initiated with a completed application claim form within 12 months of a Qualifying Event.
