

Open Educational Resources Grant Program Awardees 2023

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board is pleased to announce the 2023 awards under the Open Educational Resources (OER) Grant Program. In January 2023, the Division of Digital Learning released a Request for Applications to support faculty at Texas public institutions of higher education to adopt, modify, redesign, or develop courses that use only OER. Two categories of award were offered under this RFA – Development Grants for developing new or substantially improving existing OER and Implementation Grants for incorporating OER in courses.

Through a competitive process, seven applicants have been selected for Development Awards and nine applicants have been selected for Implementation Awards.
