

Open Educational Resources Grant Program Awardees 2025

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board is pleased to announce the 2025 awards under the Open Educational Resources (OER) Grant Program. In October 2024, the Division of Digital Learning released a Request for Applications (RFA) to support faculty at Texas public institutions of higher education to adopt, modify, redesign, or develop courses that use only OER. Two categories of award were offered under this RFA - Development Grants for developing new or substantially improving existing OER and Continuous implementation Grants for incorporating OER in courses. Through a competitive process, four applicants have been selected for Development Awards and eleven have been selected for Continuous Improvement Awards.
