Allocation Amount

This memo is to announce the enclosed final allocation amount for the TEXAS Grant program for the 2017-18 academic year.

On May 24, 2017, preliminary allocation figures for the TEXAS Grant program were issued to institutions. Institutions were invited to confirm that the preliminary allocation spreadsheet accurately reflected the data submitted to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). Institutions were allowed 10 days to review the data. That period ended at the close of business on June 7, 2017. Through this process, THECB received no comments about the data.

As a reminder, FY 2018 is the last year that the hold-harmless provision will be used to calculate allocated amounts to institutions. The hold-harmless provision applied to five institutions for FY 2018.

Of the appropriated amount, the THECB has chosen to carry forward three percent of the allocated amount from FY 2018 to FY 2019 in order to acknowledge the enrollment growth in years between the biennium.

Institutions participating in the TEXAS Grant program will have the opportunity to submit a funds request form as early as **August 1, 2017** and payments for these requests will be processed the first week after the first day of the new fiscal year, September 1, 2017.
