

Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Program of Study

The Program of Study Curriculum of Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning shall consist of no more than 24 identified semester credit hours that transfer and apply when students move from one institution to another and continue in a similar program. Students transferring from one institution to another should be granted credit on the basis of comparable courses completed, not on the specific numbers of credit hours accrued.
