SUBJECT: Epinephrine Auto-Injector Reporting

In June, we distributed information regarding rules and procedures adopted by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) relevant to epinephrine auto-injector policies at institutions of higher education. DSHS has requested our assistance in providing additional information.

Specifically, as required by SB 1367 (85<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature), if an institution of higher education adopts an epinephrine auto-injector policy, the institution is required to report the use of an epinephrine auto-injector to the DSHS Commissioner within 10 business days. DSHS has now implemented a webform for such reporting. The webform is located on the DSHS School Health Program website and can be accessed at the following link:
