As a reminder, institutions are **required** to use the GEER Return of Funds Form (RFF) when sending back both funds and interest. All sections on the RFF and the "Detailed Refund Explanation" need to be completed. While grant and interest refunds are reported together on the RFF, they have to be returned separately to the THECB.

The GEER RFF has been modified and can be found on the Student Financial Aid Programs (SFAP) webpage under GEER. Institutions should discard prior versions to avoid confusion. The following changes have been made to the GEER RFF:

- Added GEER Reskilling Support Fund Grant (PCA #32506). •
- Added GEER Open Educational Resources (PCA #32507). •
- Removed Recurring Transaction Index (RTI) information (for public universities) • which is now included on the revised Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Instructions.
