RE: State Financial Aid Reminders and Resource Updates

As we begin the new fiscal year, the Office of Student Financial Aid Programs (SFAP) would like to provide institutions with some reminders and updated resources that can be used throughout the year.

## **Funds Request Process**

## **Grant Programs**

Institutions can begin submitting funds requests for FY 2022 for the three state grant programs which include Toward EXcellence, Access and Success (TEXAS) Grant, Texas Educational Opportunity Grant (TEOG) and Tuition Equalization Grant (TEG). Please note that the additional funding (Strategy B.1.10) that was communicated in the final allocations for each program are being added in the grant payment portal in the coming months to reflect the full allocation amount.

## **Special Programs**

Institutions can begin submitting funds requests for FY 2022 for the Educational Aide Exemption (EAE) and the Bilingual Education Program by submitting the applicable PDF fillable form available on the Student Financial Aid Programs webpage under <a href="Program Resources">Program Resources</a>.

## **Work-Study Programs**

Institutions participating in Texas College Work-Study (TCWS) or Work-Study Student Mentorship Program (WSMP) will receive FY 2022 funds as a lump-sum payment.

**Note:** All requests and payments will be processed by Financial Aid Services after the first day of the new fiscal year, **Sept. 1, 2021**.

# College Access Loan (CAL) and Texas Armed Services Scholarship Program (TASSP) Processing

Starting in September 2021, all CAL applications that are "incomplete" after 60 days in the HelmNet portal will be deactivated. This process will ensure that the HelmNet system is current with applications that are moving through the funding process.

As a reminder, the Texas Comptroller's office payment system USAS, will be down from 7 p.m. Aug. 31 through 7 a.m. Sept. 2, 2021 for year-end processing. In order for College Access Loan (CAL) funds to arrive at the institution prior to the Comptroller's closure on Aug. 31, a student must have accepted their Loan Approval Disclosure (LAD) by Aug. 16, 2021. LAD's accepted after this date will not have funds disbursed until after the Labor Day holiday.

All FY 2022 TASSP disbursements will be processed by the THECB after the first day of the new fiscal year, Sept. 1, 2021.
