RE: FY 2019 Texas College Work-Study (TCWS) Mentorship 10-Day Allocation Data Review

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) announces the 10-day allocation data review for the FY 2019 (2018-19) Work-Study Mentorship Program (WSMP) at public and private/independent institutions. The TCWS Mentorship program is funded by appropriations through the Texas College Work-Study Program. As part of the allocation rule ([TAC, Section 22.133](#)), a 10-day review period is required, allowing institutions to review the data that is provided in the enclosed attachment, "**Texas College Work-study (TCWS) Mentorship Program Preliminary Allocation Calculation Data.**" The source of data used for the preliminary allocation calculation is based on the data submitted from institutions on the FY 2017 Financial Aid Database report and Opt-In/Out survey for state financial aid programs that was due on April 6, 2018.
