Subject: Resident Tuition and Fees Data: Texas Educational
Opportunity Grant (TEOG) Program

Beginning with 2024-25 (FY2025), the TEOG maximum award amount calculation will be based on resident tuition and fees which includes **out-of-district tuition and fees**, as well as in-district tuition and fees. On **August 2, 2023**, a negotiated rulemaking committee made a rule amendment regarding the calculation of the TEOG maximum award amount, which resulted in this change in criteria.

Currently the Integrated Fiscal Reporting System (IFRS) does NOT capture resident tuition and fees. Therefore, historical data is needed from each public community college, state college, and technical institute for Fall 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023 to accurately calculate the FY2025 TEOG maximum award amount.
