Recent disruptions are accelerating changes already underway in the economy.

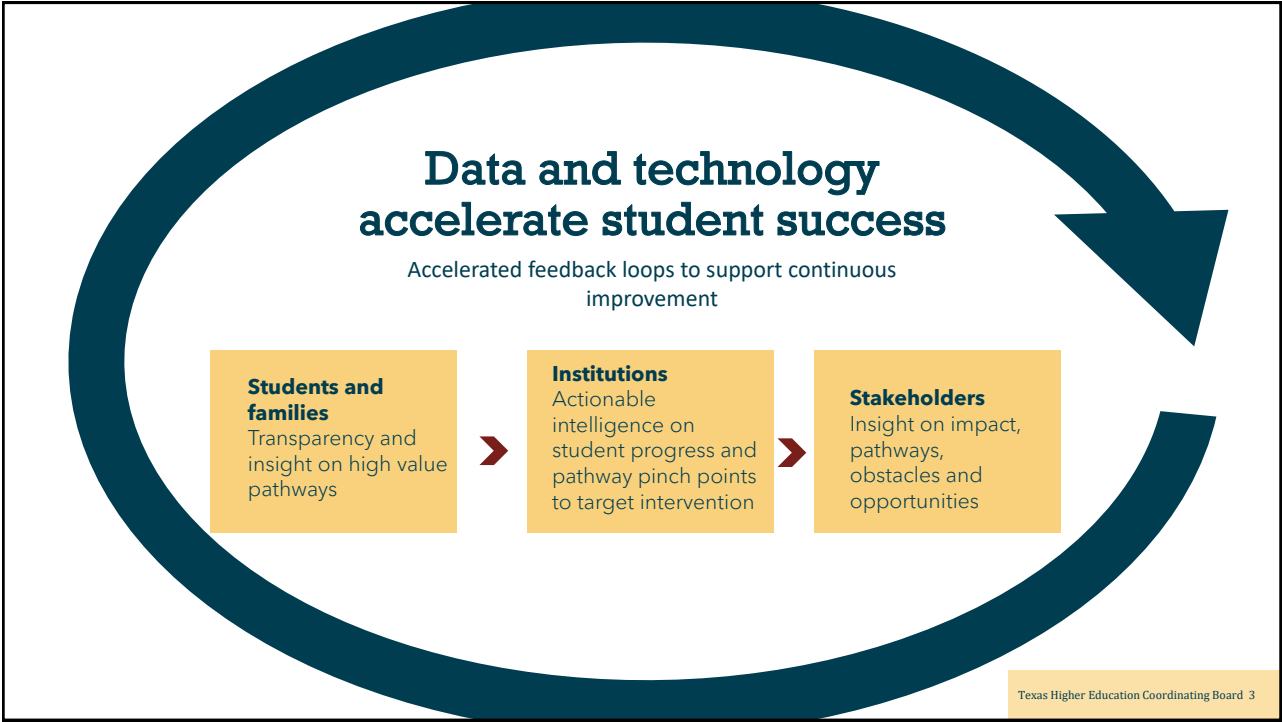
Despite high unemployment across the state, many good jobs remain unfilled.

Individual Texans are unsure about risks vs. rewards of more training and education.

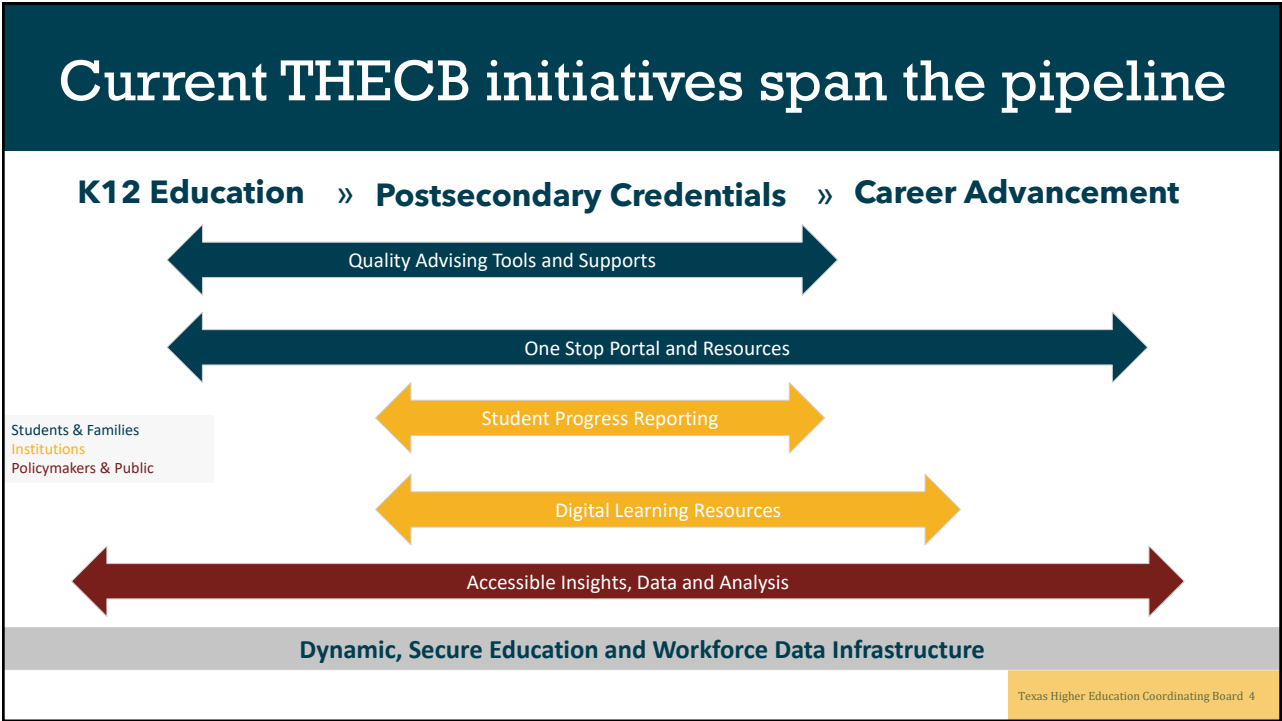
Enrollments for populations who would benefit from reskilling are generally down.
