


- Demand for College Graduates by Degree Program

  - Distribution of the population of Texas-educated workers by highest degree and field of study, 2010 to


Market alignment occurs when the proportion of job posts by degree program comes close to matching the proportion of graduates produced by degree program




Supply of Graduates Relative to Demand by Major Field of Study: **Bachelor's**

Supply of Graduates Relative to Demand by Major Field of Study: **Associate** 




Supply of Graduates Relative to Demand by Major Field of Study: Community College Certificates
