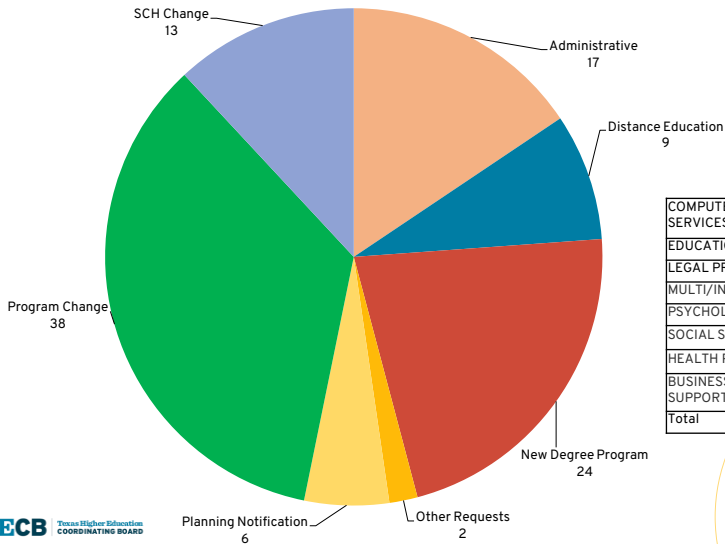

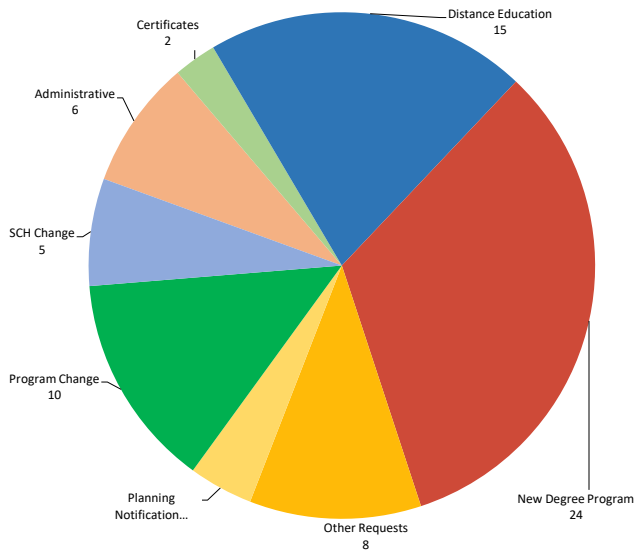

Current Implementation Priorities

Planning Notification & Delivery of Labor Market Information (effective June 1, 2023)

- Top priority for technical process design and automation.

Communication & Rollout

- Anticipate a 6+ month rollout.
- Beginning regular communication updates to institutions and monthly info sessions.
- Trainings & demonstrations.

Request Forms & Process Redesign
