



Goals

- √ Draft forms in progress for most requests affected by rule revision.

Planning Notification & Delivery of Labor Market Information (effective June 1, 2023)

- Anticipate a 6+ month rollout.
- Beginning regular communication updates to institutions and monthly info sessions.
