In March 2021, the Coordinating Board adopted the revised Transfer Rules, which implemented the new Texas Transfer framework and revised the Texas Transfer Field of Study Curriculum.

The Texas OnCourse team is developing modules that will be shared with counselors, advisors, and other educators across the state, which will be instrumental for more stakeholders including students and families being made aware of this transfer initiative to improve student success.
