GEER-funded initiatives

In July 2020, Gov. Greg Abbott and legislative leadership directed **\$175 million** in federal Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Funds to the THECB.

- \$57M to maintain State Financial Aid Programs
- \$46.5M for Emergency Educational Aid
- \$46.5M for Reskilling and Upskilling Grants
- \$10M for Online Learning Support
- \$15M for Data Infrastructure

Emergency Educational Aid

During the fall 2020 semester, 93 public institutions of higher education used GEER funds to provide Emergency Educational Grants to 40,646 students.



State financial aid programs

GEER funding has supported 17,690 Texas students across the state's public and private colleges and universities.



Reskilling and Upskilling Grants

In December 2020, the Coordinating Board announced the first round of grants totaling \$18.1M and serving an estimated 11,975 students.



Online Learning Support

The Coordinating Board awarded **\$812,000** in technical assistance grants to support applicants and awardees. Applications are open until the end of January, and **twenty-one** applications have already been received.
