

Exemplars of COVID-19 Response

Arizona

Arizona State University tested blood samples to check for COVID-19 antibodies.

Florida

University of South Florida College of Engineering used 3-D printing to create PPE for local healthcare providers.

Louisiana

Louisiana State University tested wastewater to detect the COVID-19 virus.

Massachusetts

MIT faculty established a foundation to develop free and open source contact tracing.

August 27 Application deadline; one per institution

Late September Staff recommend finalists to Commissioner

Early October Finalists are determined

October 22 Finalists recognized at quarterly Board meeting

December TBD Opportunity for finalists to present at Leadership Conference
