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Issues to Address

- Extensive manual processing of data submissions and data analysis
- Data validation rules are coded vs. configured requiring substantial ISS effort to manage/maintain
- Difficult to navigate and find data via websites due to limited search and suboptimal UX
- Limited funding to make large-scale improvements


