- Preliminary enrollment data collection began over 20 years ago
- Fall census date enrollments were collected from:
  - 2-year technical, state, and community colleges;
  - · 4-year public and independent universities; and
  - public and private health-related institutions (HRIs)

- Certified fall enrollment data will be finalized later this calendar year

## Preliminary enrollment data main highlights

- Statewide enrollments are similar to last year, but have not recovered to pre-pandemic levels, especially for community colleges
- Enrollments disaggregated by race/ethnicity/gender show varied impact by group, with non-Hispanic white and Hispanic students in decline
- Enrollment patterns vary by region and institution type


