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## Preliminary Headcount Data

- Every fall for several decades, the Coordinating Board has collected preliminary enrollment counts
- This year, due to concern about variations resulting from the pandemic, the Coordinating Board conducted a special survey of summer 2020 preliminary headcount enrollments
- Census date enrollments were collected for both summer sessions from Texas public institutions (2-year technical, state, and community colleges; 4-year universities; and health-related institutions (HRIs))
- Summer enrollment data will be certified in September; final certified data will be available in the fall
- This collection had a very tight timeline and all public institutions submitted data. Many thanks to those institutional partners who provided the data to be shared today.

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Preliminary enrollments were up 11 percent statewide in summer 2020 with almost 70,000 additional students enrolled



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All groups tracked increased from summer 2019 to summer 2020; Hispanic students and those in the "Other Groups" category grew the most




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


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## Considerable variation in summer enrollment patterns across Texas provide food for thought

- Large variations were observed across sectors:
- · For universities
  - 32 of 38 universities showed increases from 2019 to 2020
  - The range of percent change went from -30% to +39% with three small regional universities showing large drops
- For community colleges:
  - 2/3rds showed increased enrollments compared to summer 2019
  - The range of percent change went from -87% to +107% for Summer I enrollments; the range was even greater for Summer II

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- TSTC enrollments are down and CTE is down at other 2-year institutions, as well
- Programs with hands-on classes may have been negatively impacted
