## Texas Research Incentive Program (TRIP) Overview

**Purpose:** Leverage private gifts for the enhancement of research productivity and faculty recruitment by providing matching funds based on how much an institution raises in private gifts and endowments.

### State Match Rate for Qualifying Gifts

- 50%: \$100,000 to \$999,999
- 75%: \$1 million to \$1,999,999
- 100%: \$2 million to \$10 million

### Institution Eligibility Criteria:

*Designated as an Emerging Research University*

## The legislature appropriates TRIP funding to the Coordinating Board for distribution

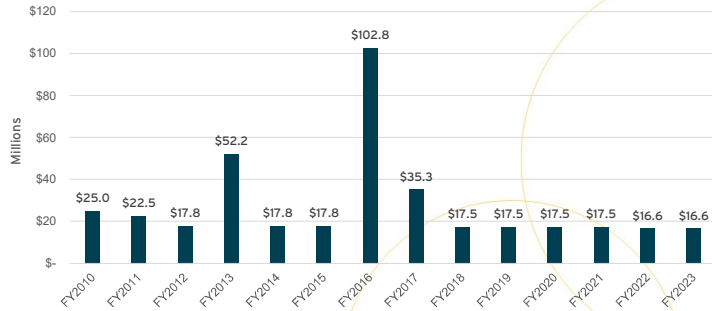
SINCE INCEPTION IN 2010, THERE HAVE BEEN:

**\$960 million in Gifts Provided to Institutions**

RESULTING IN

**\$743.9 million\* in State Matching Funds Owed to Institutions**

The legislature has funded \$394.5 million in match payments. Currently, there is \$349.4 million in unfunded matches.
