National Research University Fund

Eligibility: Emerging Research Universities (ERUs) with more than \$45 million in restricted research & meet statutory criteria

• ERUs: Texas Tech University, University of Houston, UT-Dallas, UT-Arlington, UT-San Antonio, UT-El Paso, University of North Texas and Texas State University

Statutory Criteria: Must meet 4 of the 6 for two consecutive years

- 1. Endowment >\$400 million;
- 2. Award 200+ PhDs annually
- 3. Entering freshmen class of high academic achievement
- 4. Institutional recognition of research capability and scholarly attainment
- 5. High-quality faculty
- 6. High-quality graduate programs

Funding: Eligible institutions receive an equal distribution of available funding.

• UT-San Antonio has been found eligible, pending an SAO audit




