# Introduction

This report summarizes the Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA) and Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) scores of Texas public high school graduates in 2022. Report tables present TSIA and TSIA2 average scores by public school district and by race or ethnic group within each district. This report meets the requirements of Texas Education Code (TEC), Section 51.3062(u), with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) providing the TSIA data for this report on behalf of institutions of higher education statewide.

**Note:** The TSIA is one way of demonstrating college readiness in Texas. Other reports that consider the comprehensive list of readiness measures can be found on our <u>Texas Higher</u> <u>Education Data website</u>, and policy information is available on the <u>Texas Success Initiative</u> <u>website</u>.

# **Matching Methodology**

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) receives from the College Board (1) Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA) scores of students who had tested at either a Texas higher education institution or within a public school district testing site from June 2011 through October 2022 and (2) Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) scores of students who had tested at either a Texas higher education institution or within a public school district testing site from January 2022 through October 2022. The Texas Education Agency (TEA) matches the 2021-22 annual graduates file in PEIMS with the TSIA and TSIA2 data, using an algorithm that includes the graduates' SSN, first name, last name, and date of birth. Then, the TEA uses an identifier in PEIMS to connect students to the graduating campuses.

#### **Student Privacy and Data Suppression**

The THECB suppresses information that could be used to identify individual students. The THECB took the following steps to protect the privacy of students within the state:

- No TSIA or TSIA2 data were shown where the number of test takers in a district is fewer than 100. For these districts, THECB plans to provide a "small N report" every three years.
- TSIA and TSIA2 data for any ethnic group with fewer than five test takers were suppressed.
- District summaries were calculated using only the total number of students and average of the data that are presented. Suppressed student groups were not included in these calculations.
