ADMINISTRATOR'S STATEMENT

CORE COMPONENTS

The governing Board of Cisco College consists of nine members. Board members are elected at large from the Cisco College taxing district, which represents the western portion of Eastland County. EMPLOYMENT BACKGROUND CHECKS

Cisco College conducts background checks on all full-time personnel. All employment offers for full-time personnel including security sensitive positions are contingent on successful back ground checks and approval by the college's governing board. These background checks are conducted by the Director of Human Resources.

Background checks are conducted on all security-sensitive positions as permitted by the Texas Government Code, Sec. 411.094 and Texas Education Code, Section 61.003 (8), and consistent with the college's human resources policies and procedures.

SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN POLICY

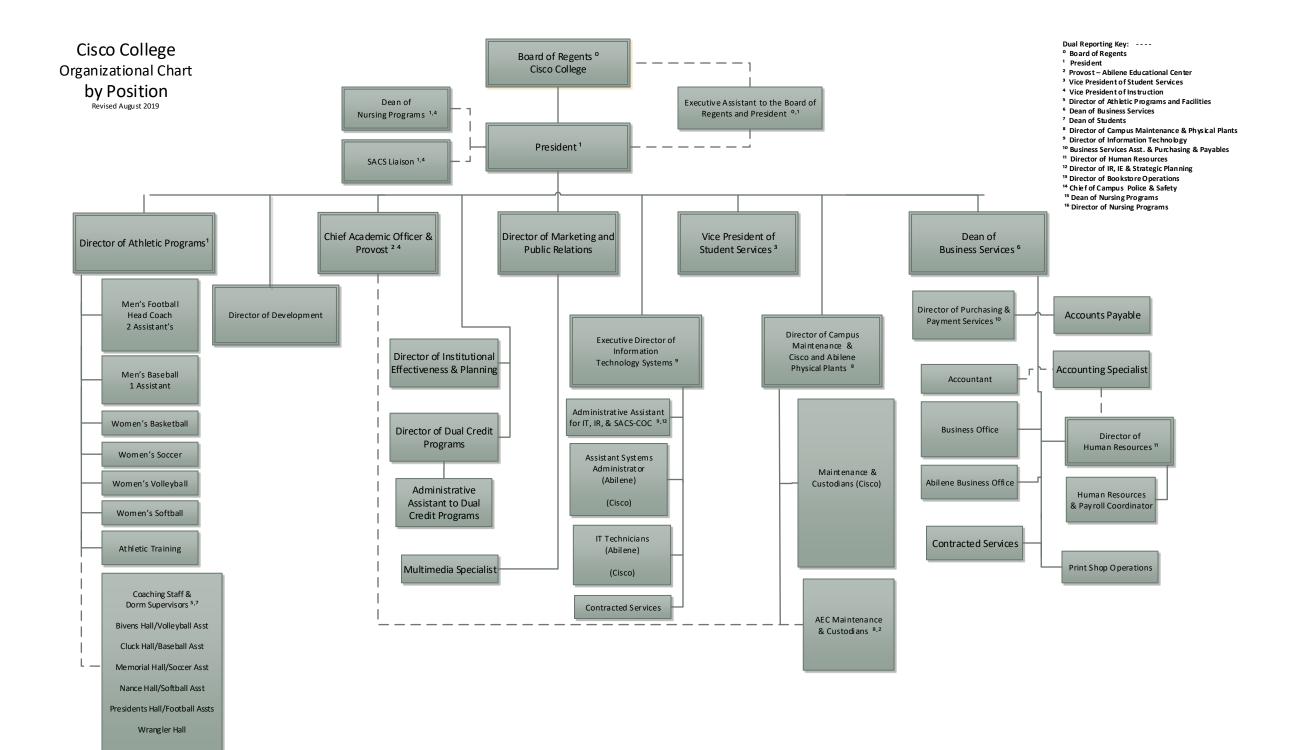
There are no significant changes in policy which impact this budget request.

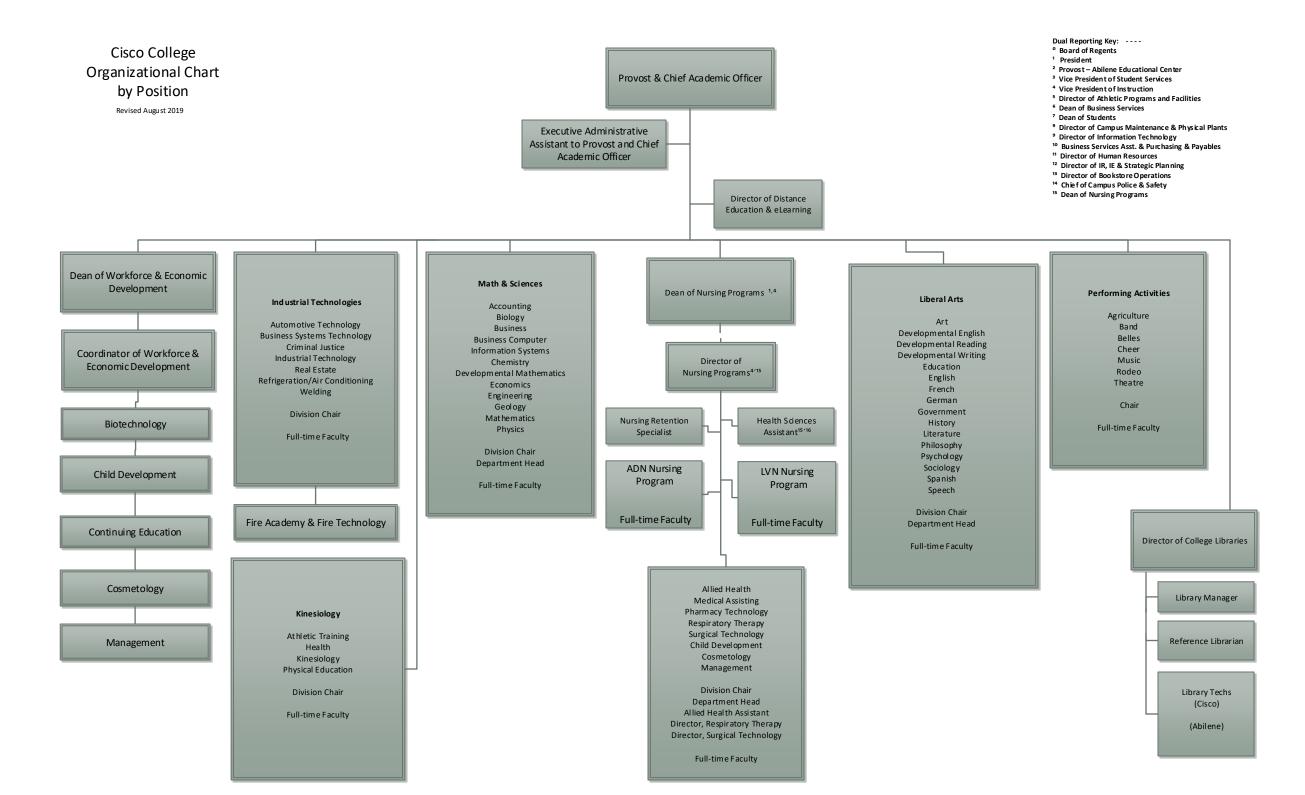
COLLEGE BUDGET PROCESS

The college's budget process is coordinated by the Dean of Business Services/CFO and Administration. The impact of COVID 19 on the college's budget continues to be evaluated. A portion of the costs incurred from COVID 19 to transition to all online courses in the spring 2020, the purchase of personal protective equipment, and the installation of cough/sneeze guards on both campuses were covered through CARES Act funding. However, enrollment declines (Fall -9.4%) and declining revenue in auxiliary programs will continue to have a negative impact on the college's core operations.

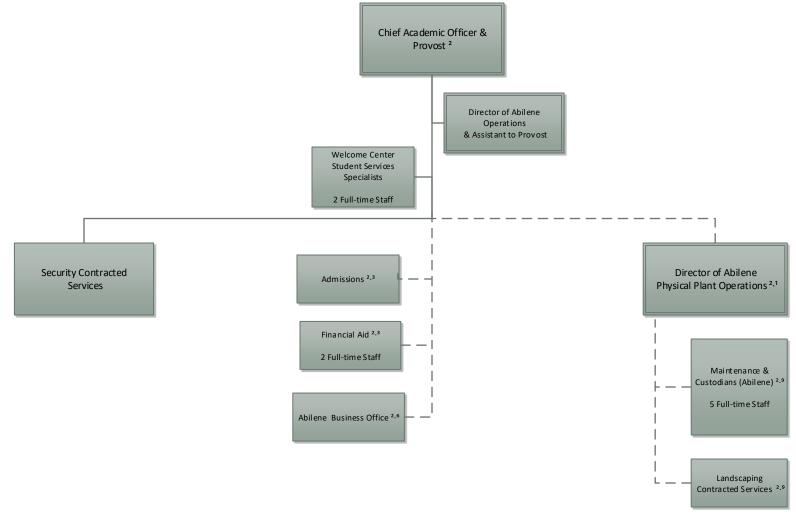
Cisco College respectfully supports the \$1.83 billion formula funding request submitted by the Texas Association of Community Colleges (TACC) in its letter to the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor's Office, Budget Division. State support remains critical to the district as it continues to fulfil its statutory role and mission to offer vocational, technical, and academic courses for certification or associate degrees. Together with Texas' other 49 community college districts, we will continue do much of the heavy lifting in the state's efforts to achieve the 60X30TX plan. State support will further be necessary to help address costs related to mitigating the effects of the pandemic, including transitioning to distance education, providing for personal protective equipment, and safely delivering the required in-person instruction essential for students in healthcare and other technical/vocational programs.

In response to the economic downturn resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, Texas community colleges began developing a workforce initiative aimed at providing low or no-cost short-term workforce training leading to high-demand credentials to Texans whose employment and/or academics had been recently disrupted. Cisco College respectfully supports the \$50M exceptional item request submitted by TACC in support of this statewide workforce initiative, funded in the amount of \$1M per college district for the 2022-23 biennium.





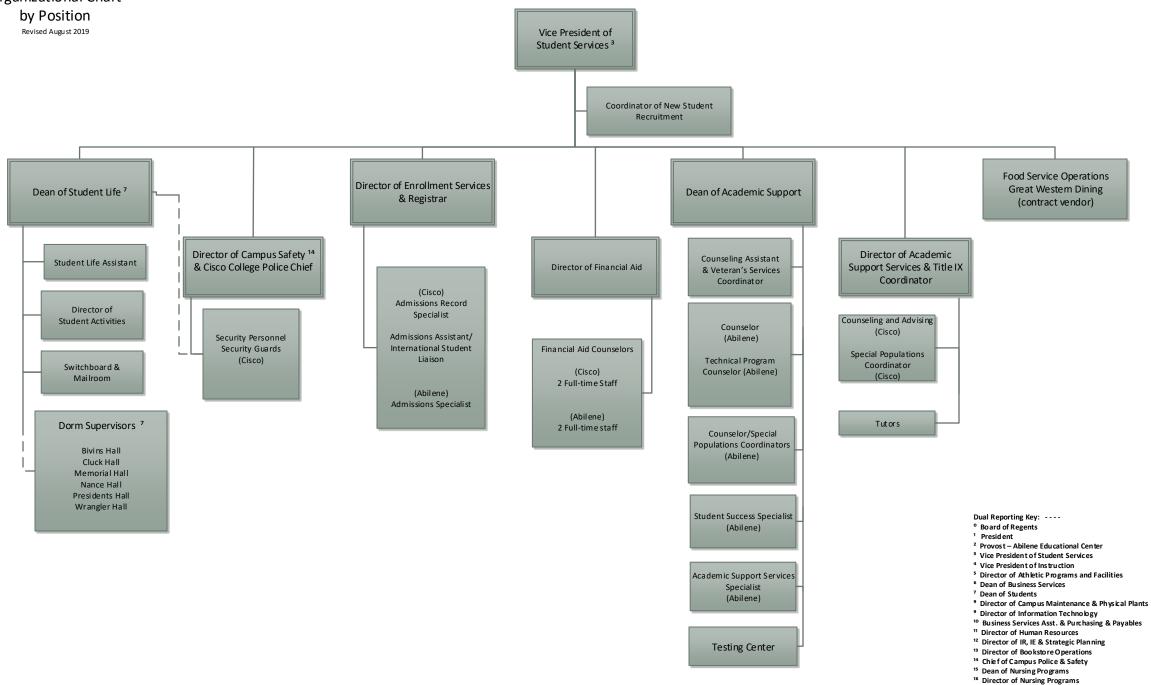
Cisco College Organizational Chart by Position Revised August 2019
