Administrator's Statement 87th Regular Session, Agency Submission, Version 1 Automated Budget and Evaluation System of Texas (ABEST)

969 Lee College

Lee College District respectfully supports the \$1.83 billion formula funding request submitted by the Texas Association of Community Colleges (TACC) in its letter to the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor's Office, Budget Division. State support remains critical to the district as it addresses costs related to mitigating the effects of the pandemic, including transitioning to distance education, providing for personal protection equipment, and safely delivering required in-person instruction.

In the wake of COVID-19 pandemic, Texas community colleges began developing a workforce initiative aimed at providing low or no-cost short-term workforce training leading to high-demand credentials to Texans whose employment and/or academics had been recently disrupted. Lee College District respectfully supports the \$50M exceptional item request submitted by TACC in support of this statewide workforce initiative, funded in the amount of \$1M per college district for the 2022-23 biennium.

The Legislative Appropriations Request (LAR) for the 2022/2023 biennium is the fiscal representation of the Lee College District's strategic planning process. The District is facing financial challenges in the coming years that will greatly impact the District's ability to educate and serve the citizens of our service area. With continued support from the State of Texas, Lee College will make the following investments:

- Supporting Distance Learning
- Workforce Program Expansion
- Dual Credit Expansion
- Pathways Development

Lee College continues to focus on the goals set forth in the 60x30TX Higher Education Strategic Plan. The College is innovating around the pandemic by rapidly developing knowledge, skills and abilities for both online instruction and student services. The College will be instrumental to the post-COVID economic recovery by strengthening and expanding our workforce programs. The College is expanding its dual credit program with MOUs with ISD partners providing free tuition to students who enroll full-time right after graduation. Our Pathways work extends down into earlier grades and upwards to transfer institutions, with an emphasis on quality academic advising.

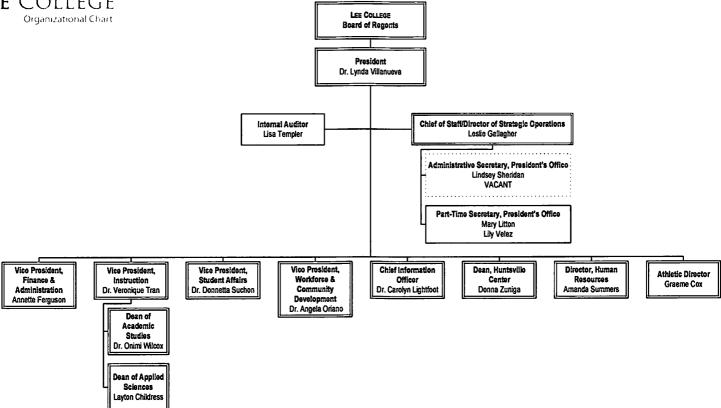

USE OF HOMELAND SECURITY FUNDS

Initially, an outside firm was brought in to disinfect the entire campus. Housekeeping staff was trained on the proper disinfecting process to use in maintaining all facilities. This cleaning process has increased the purchase of cleaning supplies as well as PPE. A safety expert has been retained by the college to help define classroom and work space areas to ensure proper social distancing is maintained. The college has moved instruction to an on-line or hybrid platform. Faculty members have attended over 1,300 total hours in quality training and have been certified by Lee College to teach courses on-line. Essential staff, (security, facility maintenance/housekeeping, and administration) are reporting to campus as needed. Anyone reporting campus is following the College's daily safety check-in protocol. These processes are based on the CDC and local authority recommendations. Movement throughout campus is monitored to ensure compliance. The college has purchased laptops, monitors, and other electronic devices. The equipment is available to be checked out by faculty, staff or students. The College developed an Emergency Aid program that provides \$250 to \$1,500 directly to eligible students based on four criteria (housing, food, child care, college) and also allows students to receive laptop computers and other equipment to support learning. The Emergency Aid program will continue to be used to evaluate and award aid to qualifying students.
