- Fall 2018: Launch of Z-Degree program

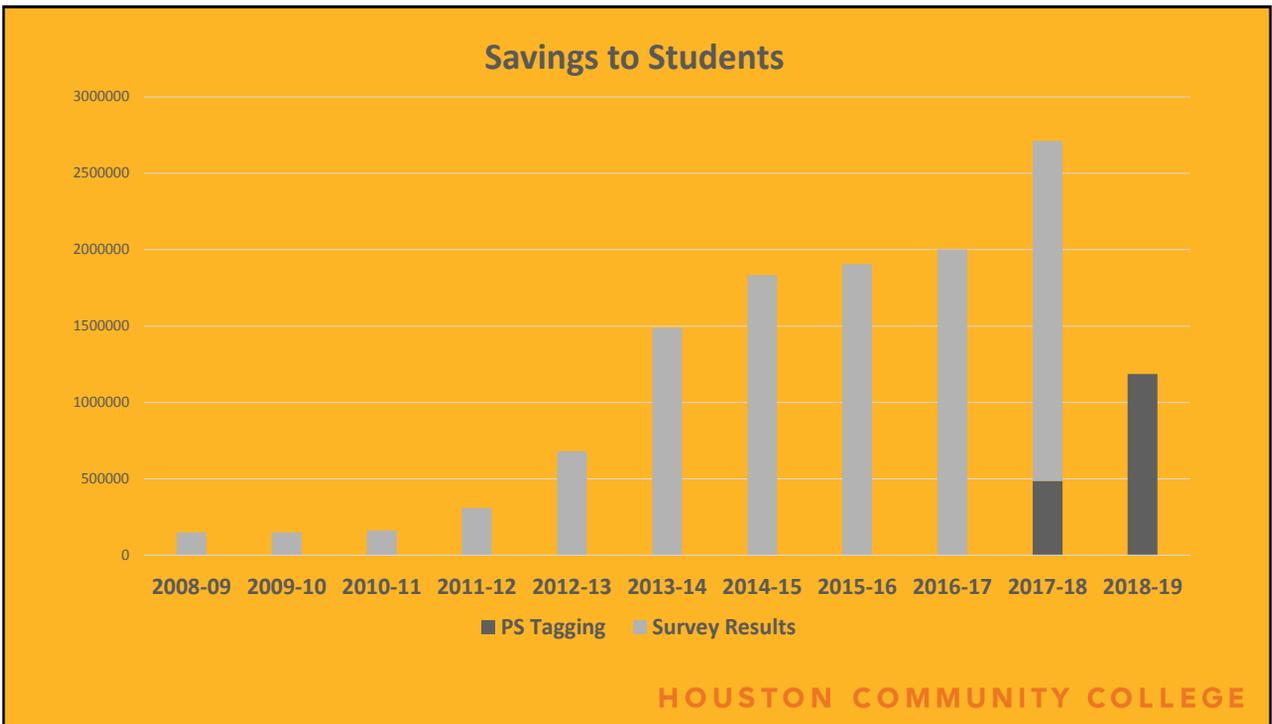
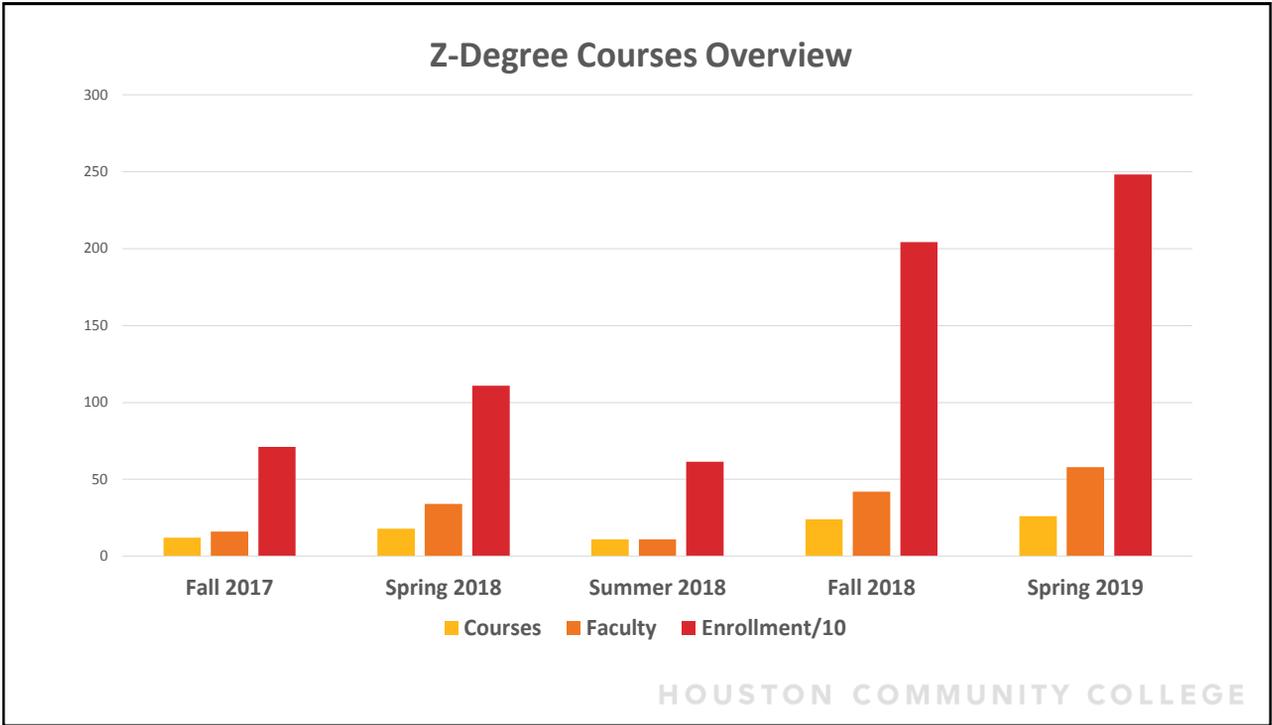
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OER Programs at HCC



- Z-Degree Program:
 - Three current degree pathways:
 - AA, Business Administration
 - AA, Multidisciplinary Studies
 - AS, Multidisciplinary Studies
 - Zero-cost Core Curriculum at 9 largest campuses by 2020
 - Structured schedule of classes, M-Th, plus online options
- OER promotion and increasing adoption
- OER Training Certificate Program
- OER Course Certificate Program
- Stipends for Creation, Adaptation, and Updates to OER Content
- Course Tagging in the PeopleSoft Student Schedule (Low-Cost Books and Zero-Cost Books)

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Next Steps

- Improve OER offerings in Dual Credit
- Continue to expand Zero-Cost and Low-Cost Books offerings:
 - Z-Degree is currently at 4 major campuses
 - Looking to 9 campuses by 2020
- Develop, update, and improve content
- Assess outcomes for students – what is the impact of OER on enrollment, retention, success, persistence, and completion?
