ACCESS & SUCCESS

South Texas College (STC) was selected as one of three community colleges in Texas by the 78th Legislature in 2003 to pilot offering a maximum of **five** applied baccalaureate degrees. During the 80th Legislature in 2007, the pilot status was removed, but maintained the maximum limit of five applied baccalaureate degrees.

The offering of baccalaureate degree programs at STC over the last 10 years has significantly impacted student access and success. Over **1,800 students** have earned bachelor degrees with a notable number of them choosing to pursue post baccalaureate degrees at the Master's level and beyond.




At right are student demographics based on data collected for Fall 2018 for students enrolled in upper-level courses in the baccalareate programs.
