## OUR ORGANIZATION AND GOVERNANCE

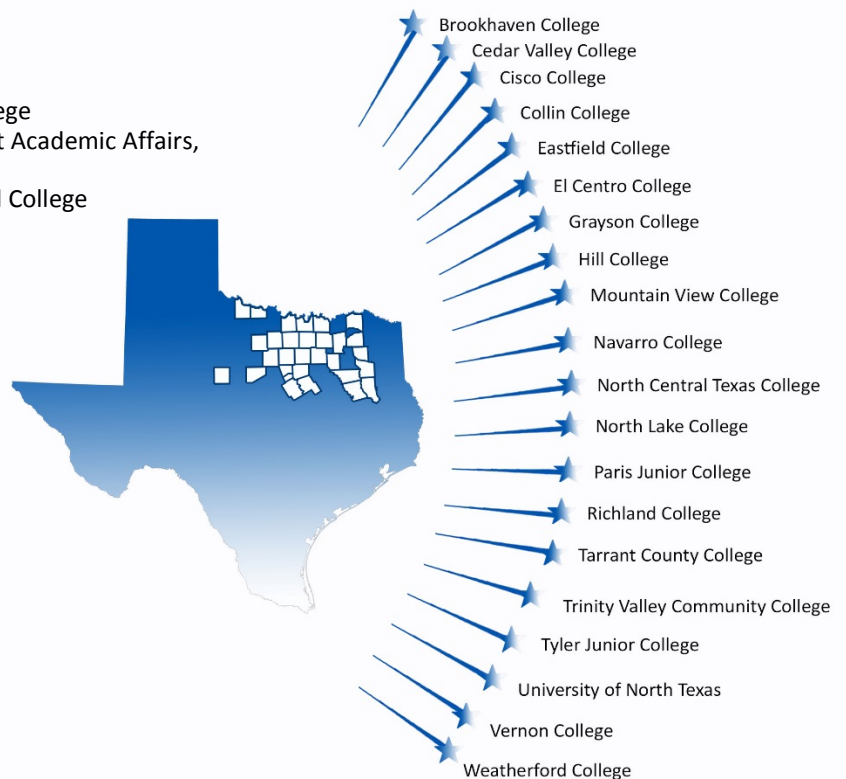
- ★ The Board of Directors (presidents and chancellors of member institutions) governs the Consortium.

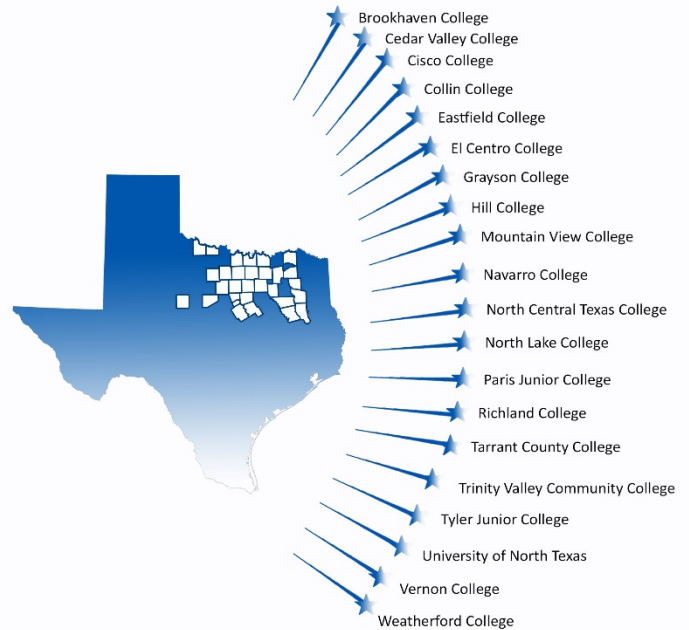
