The accountability system includes
some data for all institutions with a
Texas presence

- The system is primarily for public institutions
- Career (for-profit) and non-Texas institutions that offer degrees were included in the system in 2011
- Texas is one of only 9 states that collects private, for-profit institutional information
- State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA) establishes state-level reciprocity for online program authority; this removed reporting requirements for some out-of-state institutions



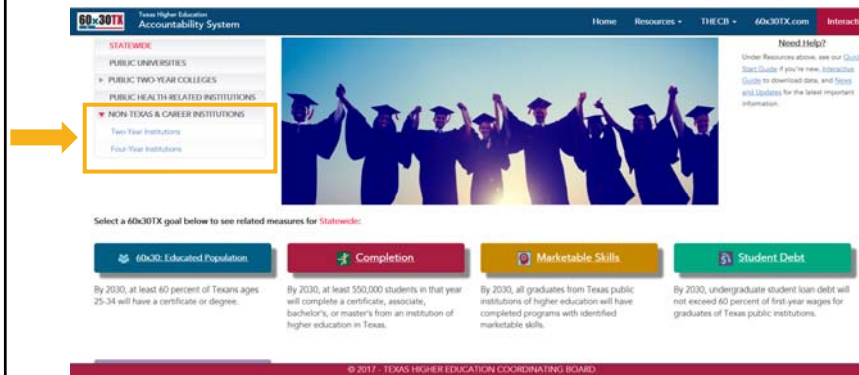
Institutions have been actively engaged in the measure revision process
