Why is CLI a part of the UT Medical School?

The Children's Learning Institute:

- takes a scientific approach to evaluating learning delays, syndromes, and the brain
- evaluates and monitors children in clinical settings
- prepares medical students and residents in child development concepts
- provides summer tutoring programs for medical school students seeking research experience





CLI is unique in its approach to studying the **whole child**, across various learning **environments**, with a **research to practice** focus that brings effective interventions to scale through state and private **partnerships**.



CLI's Clinical Programs

The **Center for Autism and Related Conditions** and the **Dan L. Duncan Children's Neurodevelopmental Clinic** offer clinical assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of socio-emotional and learning disorders for children and young adults.

At the **Center for Neurosciences**, both pediatric and adult patients with a variety of neurological conditions that can affect brain function are screened in order to aid in diagnosis and treatment through neuropsychological testing.





Community Tutoring Programs

Dan L. Duncan Reading Initiative:

Summer Tutoring Programs

Targeted reading instruction tutoring for grades K-8.

Dan L. Duncan Reading Initiative:

School-Based Programs

Early intervention for students who are at-risk for reading failure as well as enrichment programs for students with grade level academic skills.

Math Tutoring and Summer Camps:

CLI is expanding its mathematics support with K-2 tutoring services and a math school ready summer camp for entering children entering kindergarten.



Cutting-Edge Research

Developmental Consequences Of Pediatric Traumatic Brain Injury Study

- Funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the National Center for Injury Prevention and Control
- Goal is to design developmentally appropriate supports for children after traumatic brain injury that will allow them to participate fully at home, in school, and in the community.

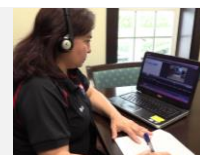
