

# Student Deposit Scholarships (SDS)

#### **Student Deposit Funds:**

- Income from the investment
- Time deposits of the general deposits
- Forfeited general deposits

# Texas Public Educational Grant (TPEG)

#### **TPEG Set-Aside Funds:**

- Each public institution is required to put money aside for grant funding.
- No more than 10% can be used for emergency loans.
- Interest earned on these funds can be used only for grants, not loans.

# **Emergency Loans**

## **Emergency Loans from Set-Asides:**

- Each public institution can establish an emergency loan program. Students are loaned money to pay tuition, fees, and the costs of textbooks.
- Short-term loans typically must be repaid within 90 days.










# Submitting a CONTACT US
